- Pray for your group discussion time!
- Choose a few questions from the guide that will generate the most discussion in your group.

GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

• What's something you say you 'love'—but isn't on the same level as loving a person? (e.g., pizza, naps, coffee, etc.)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Have someone read 1 Corinthians 13:13.
- 2 How does the Bible's definition of love differ from how our culture often defines it?
- 3. 1 Corinthians 13:13 says, "The greatest of these is love." Why do you think love is considered the greatest?
- 4. What does it mean that love is a choice and an action, not just a feeling?
- 5. Who in your life have you struggled to love? Without naming names, what made it difficult?
- 6. Why is forgiveness so essential to loving others well?
- 7. Have you ever experienced a change in feelings toward someone after choosing to act in love first? What happened?
- 8. Jesus commands us to love our enemies, do good, bless, and pray for those who mistreat us. Which of these four actions do you find hardest, and why?
- 9. In Revelation 2:4-5, Jesus tells the church to "remember, repent, and do the things you did at first." How might these steps apply to a relationship that has grown cold?
- 10. What would it look like for you to choose to love someone again today, even if the spark or feeling has faded?
